- The name of this association is the Ramjas Foundation.
 Delhi.
- II. The objects for which this association hereinafter referred to as the Poundation' is established are :-
 - To provide School and University education for Boys and Girls.
 - 2. To maintain Schools, Colleges, Boarding Houses and Training Institutions for training of teacher.
 - 3. To provide means for imperting Technical and
 Industrial education in connection with Institutions
 under the control of the Foundation.
 - 4. To provide means for imparting a sound moral and catholic religious education free from superstitious and controvers al matters and based on the Vedas and ancient Shastras.
 - 5. To encourage and take part in Scientific Research
 of various kinds as well as in the study, translation
 and publication of the Sanskrit Literature and | |
 Philosophy of Angient India.
 - 6. To amalgamate with the Foundation any other societies having objects similar to those or any of these of the Foundation.
 - 7. To give loans to the Institutions aided, run, managed by or under the control of the Foundation and for the benefits of the students studying in the said institutions, aid, grants, donations, subscribe to Government and/or Semi-Government Relief Funds, award Scholarships. Fellowships, Stipends of any kind as also to take, accept, donations, gifts and charities ofc.
 - 9. To sequire or mechase properties, shares, debentures or other securities.

RULES AND RECOLATIONS OF THE RAMJAS FOUNDATION, DELHI.

Preliminary.

In the following Rules and Regulations unless otherwise clearly stated, the following words will have the meanings noted against each :

The 'Foundation' will mean the 'Ramjas Foundation, Delhi.'

'Property' will mean the movemble and immovemble property belonging to the Foundation of any time.

The 'Secretary' will mean the Secretary or Honorary Secretary of the Ramjer Foundation.

The 'Board' will mean the Board of Trustees of the Ramjes.

Foundation.

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

- The Board will consist of individual members only who may be permanent or temporary and not less than 21 years of age, provided that the non-individual existing members of the Board will continue as members of the Board.
- (a) Temporary members of the Board will be those individual persons, who are recommended for the purpose by the Managing Committee of the Foundation and who agree to become members of the Board and who are elected in a General Neeting of the Board by a 2/3rd majority of the members of the Board present at the meeting.

by virtue of their educational qualifications, social status, or exceptional devotion to the cause of education in general or of the Foundation/particular and likely to prove useful to the Foundation. Such members will be temporary members and will be elected for a maximum period of three years at any one time and will be eligible for re-election at the expiry of his/her term. Number of such temporary members will not exceed 1/10th or the other members subject to a maximum of five.

- (b) Permanent members of the Board will consist of a
- (i) all the existing members of the Board.
- (ii) those individual persons who donate Rs.5,000/or more to the Foundation and agree to become the members of the Board and are elected in a describ Meeting of the Board.

(iii) Those individual persons who donate Rs. 25,0007- or more
to the Foundation will be designated as Patrons of thu
Foundation, and will automatically become a permanent
member of the Board unless he otherwise desires not to
become a member of the Board.

Explanation:

4.

For the removal of doubts, if any, It is clarified that 'donate' has the same meaning as 'gift' in section 122 of the Transfer of Property Act, 1882.

- (c) Not-withstanding anything contained in Clauses (ii) and (iii) the persons whose donations are accepted, shall be entitled to become members Patrons of the Foundation or its Board only on their being elected so by a two-third majority at a General Meeting of the Board with not less than 75% members attending.
- 3. A member of the Board shall cease to be such in the following cases :
 - (a) In case of an individual if he dies or becomes of an unsound mind.
 - (b) If he resigns, from the date of acceptance of his resignation by the Board.
 - (c) If he fails to be personally present at six consecutive meetings of the Board, for reasons which are considered in-adequate by a 2/3rd majority of the remaining members of the Board.
 - (d) If not loss than 4/5th of the members are unanimous in considering that his continuance as a number of the Board is detrimental to the true interests of the Foundation.
 - (e) It he is adjudicated an insolvent.
 - (i) If he is held guilty of any-criminal offence involving moral turpitude.

General Meetings of the Board.

The ordinary General Meeting of the Board shall be held once in a Calendar year.

A thirty days notice shall be given to the members for the ordinary denoral Meeting.

 All other Gineral Meetings of the Board shall be called Special General Meeting. At the Ordinary General Meeting the Word shull

- (a) appoint by election from amongst its own members a President, a Secretary and a Joint Secretary of the Board for the Managing Committee in place of these retiring, who will be digible for re-election.
- (b) elect the office-bearers of the Managing Committee i.e. Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary and Joint, Socretary.
- (c) uppoint Auditor or Auditors for the ensuring Financial Year.
- (d) consider the Annual Report including those of the Managing Committee and the Sub-Committees, as well as examine and consider Balance Sheet and the consolidated Budget of the Foundation and its Institutions.

- (e) consider any other proposals or metters of importance of which due notice has been given in the Agenda. One fourth of members of the Board shall form a quorum.
- Whenever there is no quorum within half an hour after
 the time fixed for any General Meeting, it shall be adjourned to some time (not later than the tenth subsequent
 day) and place, to be fixed by the members present, of which
 at least three days notice shall be given to the remaining

At such adjourned meeting, without regard to querum the members present may at their discretion either proceed to the transation of the business or adjourn the meeting as before to some other time or place, or dissolve it.

of the President, may whenever he thinks fit, and shall upon a requisition with a Statement of object made in writing to that effect and signed by not less than seven members of the Poard, convone a Special Coneral Meeting. Such special requisition with the statement of object shall be delivered personally to the Secretary or sent to him by post.

- 10. Any member of the Board desiring to bring forward any business at an Ordinary General Meeting must give not less than Twenty days' notice thereof to the Secretary who shall place the same before the Ordinary General Meeting.
- The Chairman may with the consent of the members adjourn any General Meeting from time to time and from place to place, but no business shall be transacted/any such adjourned meeting other than the business left unfini hed at the meeting at which adjournment took-place.
- 12. Every member of the Board shall have one vote only, but the Chairman shall have a second or casting vote in cases of equality of votes only.
- 13. Notes of the proceedings of every General Meeting shall be recorded by the Secretary or in his absence by any other member of the Poerd who may be asked by theChairman to do so and this record shall be signed both by the Writer of the Proceedings and the Chairman of the meeting.
- 14. The Secretary, or in his absence the Joint Secretary shall arrange to forward without delay copies of resolutions passed at any Constal Meeting of the Board to the Sub-Committees, functionary or the individual concerned as the case may be.

Manacing Committee and Sub-Committees.

- The Management of Various institutions of the Fouristion shall subject to the general control of the Board, rest with a Managing Committee consisting of not less than Seven members and not more than fifteen members who shall be elected in a General Meeting of the Board from amongst its own members.
- 16. The members shall hold office for three years, but may on the expiry of their term be re-elected.
- 17. One third of the members of the Managing Committee shall retire annually and shall be replaced by the members elected at the Annual General Meeting of the Board. Not-withstanding anything contained in rule 16 of the contrary, the intirement of one third of the members of the existing

Managing Committee shall be by ballot in 1919 and 1920 and thereafter by rotation, the retiring members being, in each case eligible for re-election.

- 16. In case of a vacancy caused by resignation or death or otherwise among the members of the Managing Conveittee, the later may fill it by election from amongst the members of the Board for the rest of the term of the vacating member.
- 19. The Managing Committee may appoint one of more subcommittees for carrying on the management of the properties,
 assests and various institutions of the Foundation by
 election from amongst its own members or those of the Board.
- 20. The Managing Committee may appoint at its discretion any member of the tutorial staff or any other person for efficient management of any institution as a member of the Sub-Committee provided that the number of such members shall not exceed 1/3rd of the total strength of the Sub-Committee.

the Managing Committee & the Sub-Committee.

- 21. The Managing Committee shall have control over all the funds and other property of the Poundation subject to the general supervision of the Board, with the provise that no immovemble property shall be transferred or leased out, for a period exceeding five years, without the consent of three-fourth majority of the members of the Board, present at the meeting of the Foundation specially called for the purpose.
- 22. The Managing Committee shall have power to burrow money, if necessary, from individuals, Banks or the Government for the purpose of the Foundation and to pay any rate of interest on it.

23. The power of appointment dismissed and acceptance of the resignation of the paid of honorary establishment of all the Institutions of the Foundation shall rest with the Managing Committee, which may delegate its power under this rule wholly or a majority to a Sub-Committee or in case of the class IV imployees even to the Send I as:

Institution.
Orders passed under this rule by a Sub-Committee of the Board.

Head of any Institution shell be subject to a right of appeal to the Managing Committee and all orders under this rule by the Managing Committee shall be subject to a right of appeal to the Board.

- 24. Rewards, increment in pay and other remunerations for good and meritorious work done by the paid staff of the ...

 Institution shall be passed by the Managing Committee within the sanctioned budget limit for the year on the basis of the recommendations made by the Sub-Committee or Head of the Institution concerned.
- 25. Notes of proceedings of the meetings of the Managing Committee and of the Sub-Committees shall be taken and recorded at the time of the meeting.
- Committee an Annual Budget for the ensuing year and the Managing Committee shall incorporate the same in its own Budget and lay it before the Ordinary General Mouting of the Board. The Annual Budget of any Sub-Committee stay, if necessary, be revised by the Managing Committee stay, if time during the year provided that if the Consolidated budget is likely to exceed its limit, special sanction of the Board shall have to be obtained.
- 27. The Managing Committee shall frame its own rules of business well as those for the Sub-Committees, if any, from time to time consent to revision by the Board as provided to beteatter under the following rules.

Revision of Rules and making of Bye-Laws.

Regulations to make new ones from time to time at well and to make, re-peal or amend bye-laws for the conduct of the general affairs of the Institutions of the Foundation and for the despatch of business as it may be expedient provided that such bye-laws do not contravene any of the aims and objects set forth in the Memorandum of Association.

Notices.

29. Notices required to be given by the Board or by the
Managing Committee or the Sub-Committee to their members
may be given either personally or under Postal Cortificates
at their respective addresses registered with the
Foundation.
